

Entry Test for Sutton Grammar School - Saturday 21st November 2009

This page gives details of the test arrangements for Saturday 21st November 2009.

Due to the high volume of applications, we will be testing boys in both the morning and the afternoon. Your son will be tested in the **afternoon**. He should arrive at the school between **1.05pm and 1.25pm**. Tests will start at 1.45pm, and should be completed by 5pm.

Your son will have an allocated seat in the school for the test. In order that he be taken to his correct seat by the prefects, he must check in at the correct zone. The zones will be clearly identified.

His candidate number and zone are given on the email which you have received, and on the tear-off sheet at the front of the posted information pack. Zones 1, 2, and 3 are accessible via the Manor Lane entrance, zones 4 – 9 are accessible via the Greyhound Road entrance.

Will parents *please leave promptly once they have delivered their sons to the correct zone*. At the end of the tests, your son will be returned to the same zone, from which you can collect him. Do not enter the school grounds before 4.50pm, as this could be distracting for boys still working.

Please ensure that you read the information on the website about travel to Sutton Grammar School.

Boys should bring the following items with them:-

- 2 HB or B pencils
- A good quality rubber
- A snack
- A bottle of water – no fizzy drinks please
- A note of his candidate number and zone. **This is very important.**

If you have decided that you do not wish your son to sit the entrance test after all, please will you telephone the school as soon as you receive this mailing.

Assuming that he does come, we look forward to seeing him, and we hope he has a very enjoyable day with us.
