

Travel to Sutton Grammar School for the Entry Test

Sutton is extremely well served by public transport. We strongly recommend that you travel to Sutton by bus or train – or walk if you live close enough.

Please bear in mind that if you cannot get here by public transport, life would be very difficult for your son should he be offered a place here.

Our school is located in a built up area and is surrounded by very narrow roads. When candidates are brought by car and try to approach the school, there is chaos, and we are very unpopular with our neighbours.

We notify the local police of the date of our test so that they can keep an eye on traffic conditions and remove vehicles that are obstructing the road.

If you insist upon driving, please park in one of the public car parks away from the school, and walk from there. The nearest public car park is the Times Square shoppers car park, accessible from Throwley Way. There are also car parks at the St Nicholas Centre, Gibson Road, and Asda.

Do not drive along any of the roads in the shaded area of the map.



The only exception to this rule would be if you or your son had a mobility problem. If this is the case, telephone Mrs Mottershead at the school with details, and she will make a note of your car registration number, so that we can allow you to drive directly to the school gate.
