

EXAM EQUIPMENT

Check your equipment and writing instruments are in good working order a week or two before your exams commence.

You **must** carry with you all of the time, for **every** exam:

Black biros or black ink pens

Pencils and sharpener

Eraser

30cm Ruler

Protractor

Compass

Calculator + spare batteries (see below)

When a calculator is needed for an exam you **must** leave the lid or case in your bag and only take the actual calculator into the exam room. If the exam does not require the use of a calculator, you **must** leave it in your bag away from the exam room.

All of the above items **must** be in a see-through pencil case or a clear plastic bag. It is classed as malpractice to take a pencil case into an exam room if the contents cannot be clearly seen.

Remember:

- ✓ No pale coloured gel pens
- ✓ No corrector pens or fluid
- ✓ You may highlight questions on your question papers or in a question/answer book but you must **never** highlight your answers.

Prohibited items:

Mobile phone

iPod / MP3/MP4 players

Watches or Fitbits

Google Glasses

Calculators when not required in exam

Notes / writing on hands etc
