GCE Summer Exams Info for Maths Students:

Maths:

Due to the large number of yr12 students sitting the AS Maths exams, **all** yr12 students should start lessons at beginning of period 4 on Weds. 13th May and Weds 20th May.

Further Maths:

On Mon 11th May and Thurs 14th May Further Maths students may have the morning of each of these days as exam leave if they so wish.

Rules and Regulations for Yr12 School Exams

You will receive a full briefing for the public exams that take place in May/June, but this is a quick reminder for those of you sitting school exams in the two weeks prior to the main exams. Please do not book any dental or medical appointments during the run of exams.

- 1) All students should be ready to enter the hall/room at least **15 minutes** before the scheduled start time of all exams. Make sure you do not have any notes in your pockets or writing on your hands, arms or anywhere else.
- 2) No mobile phones allowed in the exam room at **any** time! This also applies to iPods and MP3/MP4 players. You **must** remove labels from drinking bottles and wrappers from all sweets and snacks. **N.B. no watches allowed in the exam room. Leave them outside, along with mobile phones etc.**
- 3) Smart dress code applies for all exams, as for a normal school day, including Art. **Lab coats or aprons must be worn for your Art exam.** Break and lunch break will be at the normal time for Art students. **N.B. Art students: no music to be played during the Art exam** (you should not have any device in the room on which to play it anyway).
- 4) Bags must be left in the two recessed areas in the corridor behind the stage (opposite the Headmaster's office and the photocopying room), and **not** in any other corridor. All pens, pencils, calculator, compass, **30cm ruler**, protractors etc. should be in a see-through pencil case or clear plastic bag. Remember to bring **all** of these instruments to school **every day**. See the '*standard equipment for exams*' list that is attached to this timetable and which can also be found on the school website. **NB:** Black biros or black ink only, and you must not use pale gel pens, or corrector fluid/pens.
- 5) **Do not write or draw on your desk.** Please quietly straighten your desk and tuck your chair under it before leaving the hall/room, and when you do leave you must do so in silence, as there will be lessons taking place as normal in the rest of the school. You should not leave until the invigilators have given you permission to do so.
- 6) **NB: the Pre-U AS exam is on Thursday 7th May starting at 9.00 am (check seat plans that will be displayed in the sports hall).**
- 7) Be sure you read the instructions regarding the fire regulation procedure.
- 8) If you are ill and unable to attend an exam, please ask someone to telephone the school office as early as possible on 020 8642 3821. Likewise, if you are unavoidably running late, you **must** call the office to advise us of this. Ensure you leave home extra early when you have an exam in order to avoid this happening. If you miss an exam for any reason, you must see your subject teacher or Head of Subject as quickly as possible, to try to arrange a time when you can sit any missed papers. **Be warned: if you are late for a school exam you will not have any time added on at the end. Your exam will finish at the same time as the other students who started at the correct time. Likewise, time will not be made up for any toilet breaks taken unless you have a medical reason that you have already advised me of.**
