RULES & REGULATIONS

Please read the Student Examination Booklet for detailed information that will be emailed to you. A few notes are written below to keep in mind.

NB: All morning exams start at 9.00am and all afternoon exams at 1.30pm.

You will be seated in the same seat for all your exams.

You should arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of each of your exams, and wait outside the hall doors until called in. Room for Languages is will posted closer to the time.

You should dress as you would for a normal school day for all of your exams.

You may take a **plastic bottle** of water into the exams, but this must be in a **clear** plastic bottle and the label must be removed. You are not allowed any other drinks. No chewing gum allowed!

We have a limited supply of equipment to lend, so remember to take all necessary items to every exam, in a clear plastic or see-through pencil case. Exam board rules state that you should use only black ink or black biros in exams, so we like you to get into that habit now. You must never use corrector pens or corrector fluid in exam answers. If you wish to use a highlighter pen on your question paper that is fine, but you must never use one on answer paper or in answer booklets.

You should only take a calculator into the exam room when it is required for the exam. You must leave the lid in your bag outside the room.

If you bring a mobile phone into school it must be switched off and put away in your bag or locker, or handed in to the school office in your personal valuables bag or in a named envelope. You must never take a mobile phone into an exam room – you risk a very real chance of being disqualified from that exam if you are found to be in possession of one, and in your A Level exams in the summer, an exam board can if they wish, disqualify you from the whole subject or even every exam you are sitting with that particular board. This same rule also applies to iPods, MP3/MP4 Players, and any other electronic devices.

Please ensure that you are not wearing a watch or fit-bit, or a rubber charity band, and check your pockets to ensure you do not have any notes in them. Make sure also that you do not have any writing on your hands, arms etc.
