RULES & REGULATIONS

- 30th April 2024 – 8th May you will be on exam leave. You should only come into school when you have an exam, unless you have an arrangement to see a member of staff. When you have completed your last exam of the day you should leave the premises and not return until your next exam.
- All school rules apply. Once you have entered the exam room you will be asked to place your lanyard under your desk and remove your mask.
- You should arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of each of your exams, and wait outside in the playground, you all will enter the main hall.
- Some exams are in different rooms, please check your timetable.
- You should wear as you would for a normal school day.
- You may take a clear bottle of water into the exams, the label must be removed. No chewing gum allowed!
- We do not have calculators that is recommended for A level Maths so please do bring your calculators for all subjects that require a calculator. We do have a limited supply of other equipment to lend, so remember to take all necessary items to every exam, in a clear plastic or see-through pencil case. Exam board rules state that you should use only black ink or black biro's in exams, so we like you to get into that habit now.
- You must never use corrector pens or fluid in exam answers. If you wish to use a highlighter pen on your question paper that is fine, but you must never use one on answer paper or in answer booklets.
- If you bring a mobile phone into school it must be switched off and put away in your bag or locker, or handed in to the school office in your personal valuables bag or in a named envelope. You must never take a mobile phone into an exam room – you risk a very real chance of being disqualified from that exam if you are found to be in possession of one, and in fact if the board wishes, they can disqualify you from the whole subject and even every exam you are sitting with that particular board. This same rule also applies to iPods, MP3/MP Players, and any other electronic devices.
- Please ensure that you are not wearing a watch or fitbit, or a rubber charity band, and check your pockets to ensure you do not have any notes in them. Make sure also that you do not have any writing on your hands, arms, or anywhere else.

On your return to school see your subject teacher or Head of subject to discuss sitting any exams you may have missed. Please do not book dental or medical appointments for the run of the exams.
